





### **TURNBUCKLES**

Each end are threaded in opposite directions so that when you rotate the body of the turnbuckle one way tension will be increased, rotate the other way and tension will be released. ### SINGLE END FORK TURNBUCKLE



Each end is threaded in opposite directions so that when you rotate the body of the turnbuckle one way tension will be increased, rotate the other way and tension will be released. A versatile fixing which allows for adjustments in precise increments, there is a large variety of turnbuckles that have fork - fork attachments.

We only offer single end turnbuckles with an M8 screw (8mm), a wider range of dual end turnbuckles are available:




Some rules of thumb with turnbuckles are:





This is a turnbuckle with an adjustable thread at only one end of the barrel. It is a versatile fixing which allows for adjustments in precise increments, there is a large variety of turnbuckles that have fork - fork attachments.




