To successfully fit your Shade sail you may need additional attachments, to bridge the gap between your fixing and chosen anchorage point. A correctly tensioned Shade Sail is the key to its longevity, so when choosing hardware it is important take the specifics of each product into consideration.

There are some key rules of thumb to keep in mind when fixing your Shade Sail using turnbuckles:

- 1. Work around your Shade sail slowly tensioning each corner ensuring that the tension is even across the sail.
- 2. Stop tensioning once the sail is rigid and flat with no creases.
- 3. Make sure that you tightly secure the fixing once happy with the tension to reduce slipping.

For example with turn buckles make sure the nut is tightened.

4. Make sure that you have allowed for future tensioning of the Shade Sail

For example, make sure there is thread left on the screw, or distance between the corner of your shade and the anchor point.







SINGLE END TURNBUCKLES


